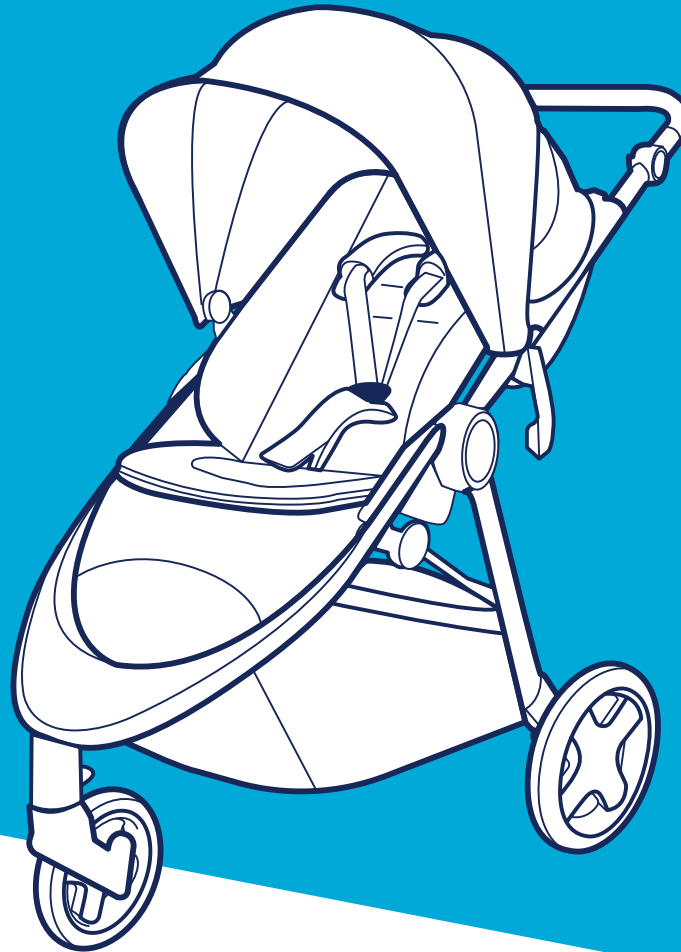

# Safety Information

## **WARNING:**

**FOR THE SAFETY OF YOUR CHILD, PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING WARNINGS AND INSTRUCTIONS AND KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.**

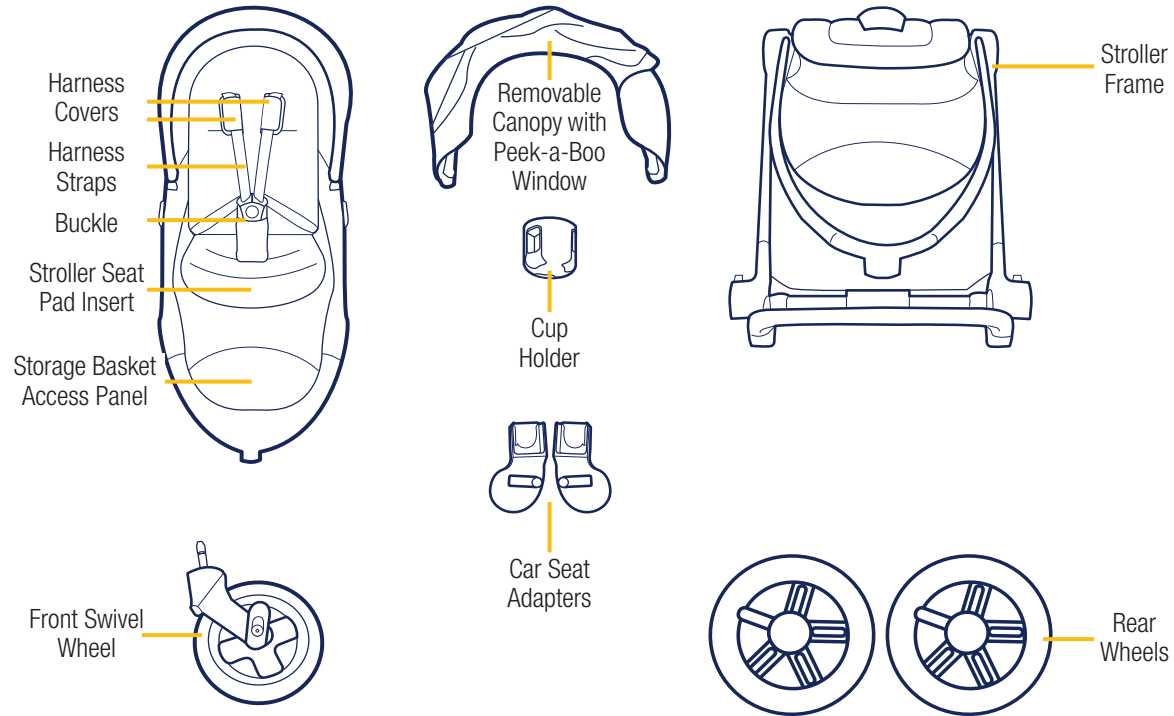
- Adult assembly required.
- **NEVER LEAVE CHILD UNATTENDED. ALWAYS** keep child in view when in stroller.
- **AVOID SERIOUS INJURY** from falling or sliding out. **ALWAYS** use the harness system. Check frequently to make sure it is secure.
- **ALWAYS** keep fingers away from moving parts, when folding, unfolding or adjusting stroller to prevent finger entrapment.
- **ALWAYS** make sure stroller is fully open and locked before using.
- **ALWAYS** use the brakes when stroller is stopped.
- **ALWAYS** remove protective material and poly bags and dispose before assembly.
- **NEVER** put hot liquids in the cup holder.
- **NEVER** use stroller on stairs or escalators.
- **NEVER** rollerblade with stroller.
- **NEVER** allow children to play with or hang onto the stroller.
- **NEVER** allow children to climb into the stroller unassisted. Stroller may tip over and injure child.

- **NEVER** place or hang parcels, bags, or accessories on the handle or canopy. The stroller may tip over or the canopy may collapse.
- This product will become unstable if a parcel bag or rack is used when there is no provision for one.
- This product may become unstable if a parcel bag, other than the one recommended by the manufacturer is used.
- This product will become unstable if the manufacturer's recommended load is exceeded.
- Care must be taken when folding and unfolding the stroller to prevent finger entrapment.
- **DO NOT** carry additional children, goods, or accessories in or on this product except as recommended in the manufacturer's instructions.
- **NEVER** place more than 2 lb (.9 kg) in cup holder.
- **NEVER** place more than 10 lb (4.5 kg) in the storage basket. If weight is exceeded, hazardous unstable conditions may exist.
- **NEVER** place more than 1 lb (.5 kg) in the storage pocket.
- **STROLLER** is only for use with children up to 65 lb (29 kg), **AND WHEN SEATED**, the midpoint of your child's head is at or below the top of the stroller seat.
- **ONLY** use this stroller with **ONE** child at a time.
- **STROLLER** is for use with children who can sit up unassisted and is **NOT** recommended for newborns.
- Failure to follow the steps and warnings on the labels and in the instruction manual can result in serious injury or death to your child.

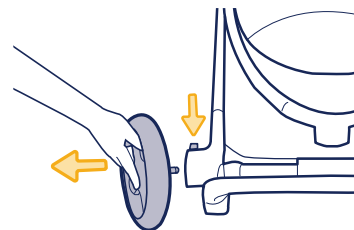


Locate and press the release button on the stroller frame.

## Removing Rear Wheels



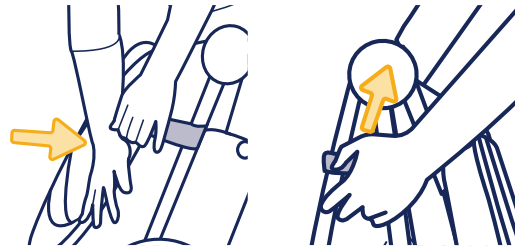
Locate and press the release button on the stroller frame. Remove the rear wheel.

Stroller Frame Latch

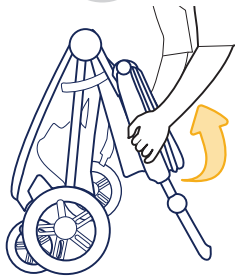

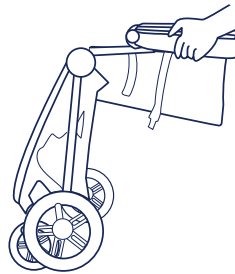


- Push in on the stroller frame to release the latch.
- Pull the stroller frame latch away from the stroller.

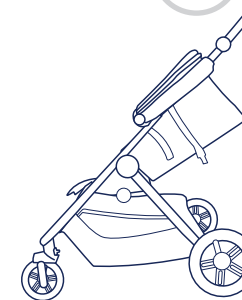

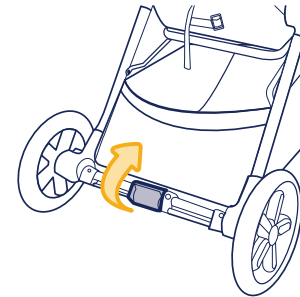

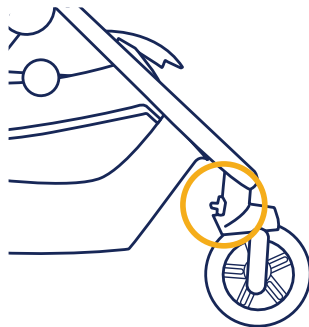

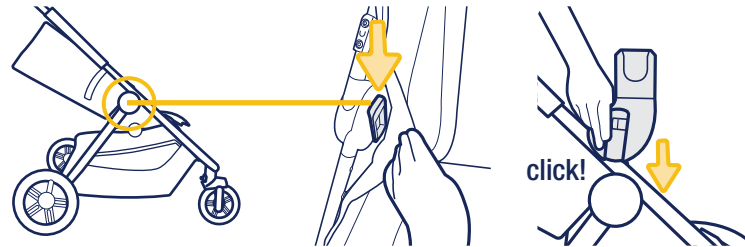
- The wheel must face forward as shown.

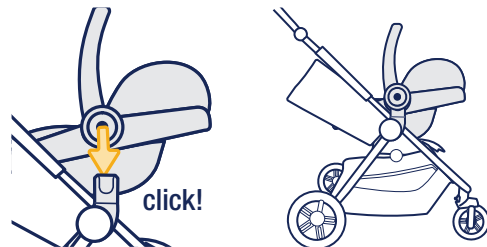

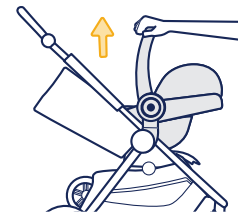
Match the colored dots on the adapters with the colored dots on the attachments located on the stroller frame. Install the car seat adapters to the attachments on the stroller frame.

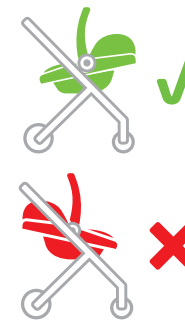


Attach the car seat to the car seat adapters. **ONLY** install the car seat rear-facing.

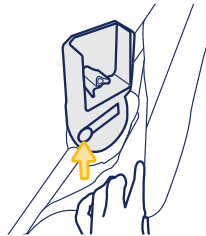
## Removing Car Seat Adapters

You **must** remove the adapters before placing your child in the stroller seat.

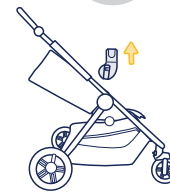

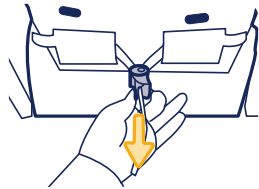

# Reclining Stroller Seat

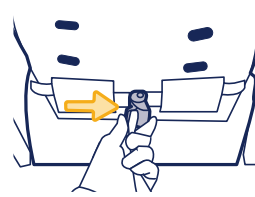
This stroller seat has multiple recline positions.

## To Recline

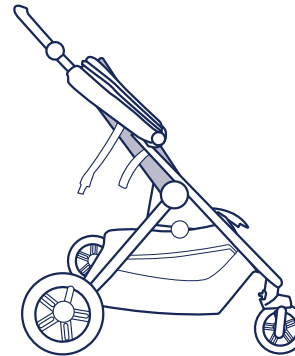


At the back of the stroller seat, squeeze the tab together and pull it towards you.

## To Make Upright



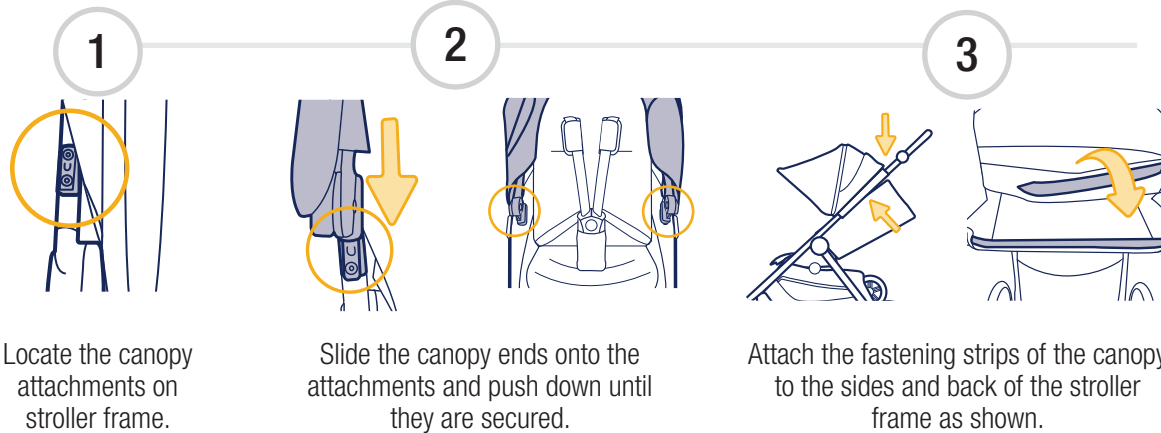
Squeeze the tab together. Push the stroller seat forward while sliding the tab up the straps.



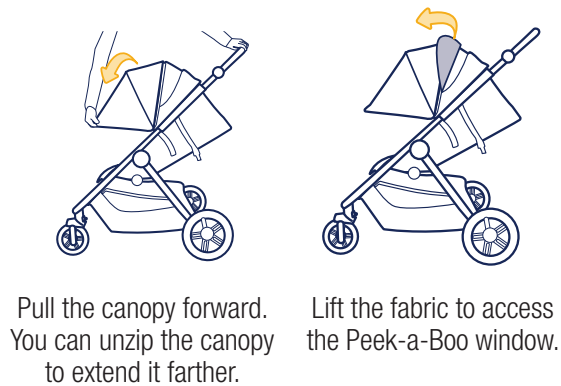

### To Shorten Harness Strap

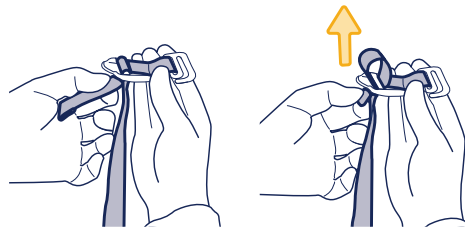


Hold the **long end** of the strap and then push it up.

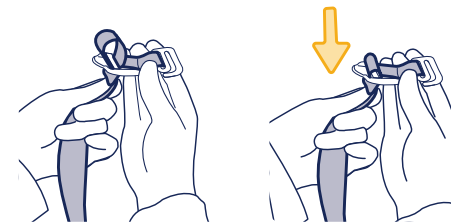


Hold the **short end** of the strap and then pull it out to tighten.

### To Lengthen Harness Strap



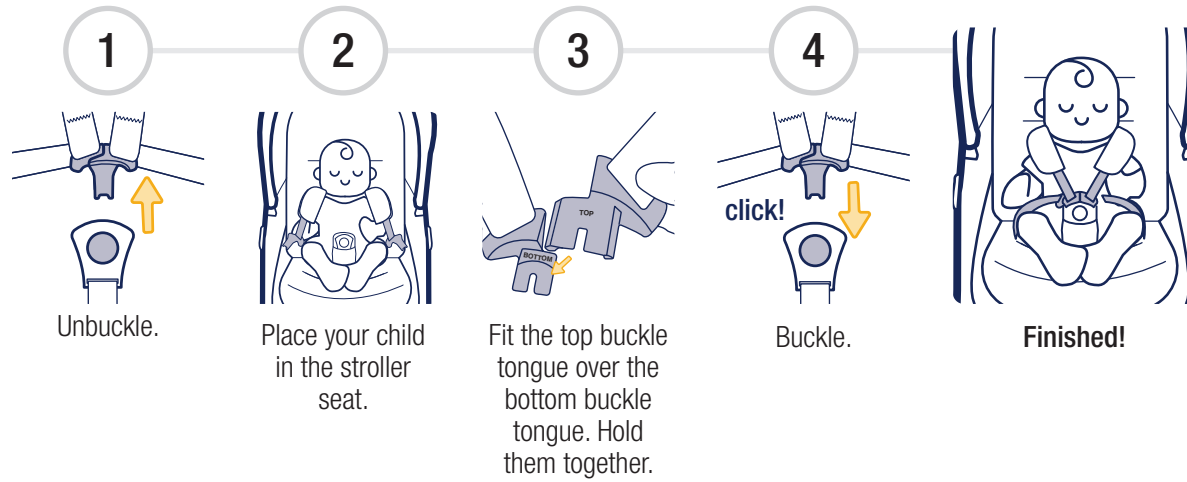
Hold the **short end** of the strap and then push it up.



Hold the **long end** of the strap and then pull it down.



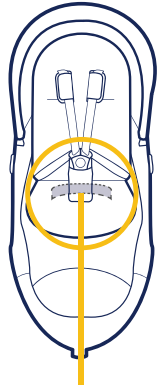
# Securing Child in Stroller Seat

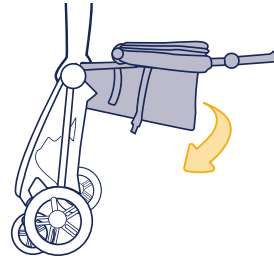

- **STROLLER** is only for use with children up to 65 lb (29 kg), and **WHEN SEATED**, the midpoint of your child's head is at or below the top of the stroller seat.
- **ONLY** use this stroller with **ONE** child at a time.
- **STROLLER** is for use with children who can sit up unassisted and is **NOT** recommended for newborns.
- Failure to follow these instructions could result in serious injury or death of your child.

# Folding Stroller



Release Handle

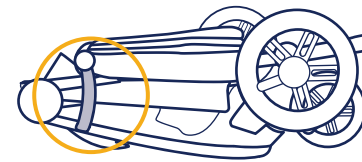


Pull the release handle up until the stroller starts to fold.

- Lift the rear wheels off the ground and tilt the stroller forward until the handle touches the ground.
- Push the stroller frame latch in.
- Push in on the frame latch to lock the frame. Make sure it is secure.



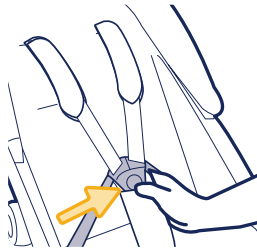

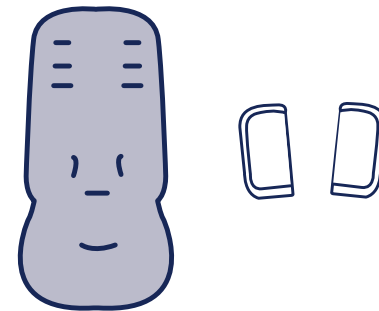
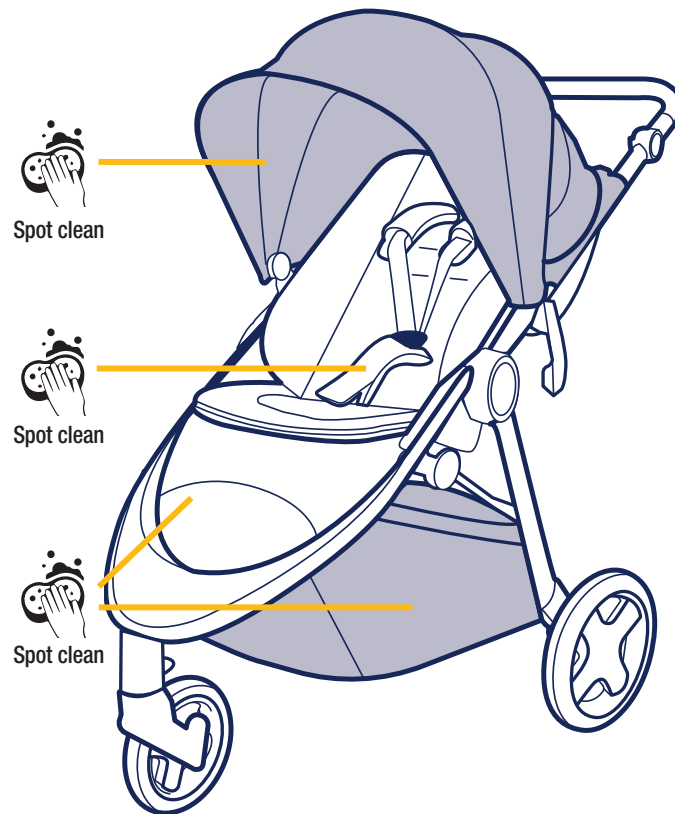
Secure the cup holder to the attachment on either side of the stroller as shown.

# Wash & Care of Stroller Parts



## Cleaning Stroller Seat Pad Insert & Harness Covers

- Machine wash separately with cold water on a gentle cycle.
- Make sure the harness covers are closed so the fastening strips are not exposed.
- Do not use bleach.
- Tumble dry separately for 10-12 minutes on low heat.
- Remove immediately.

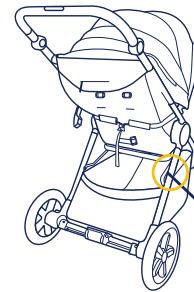
