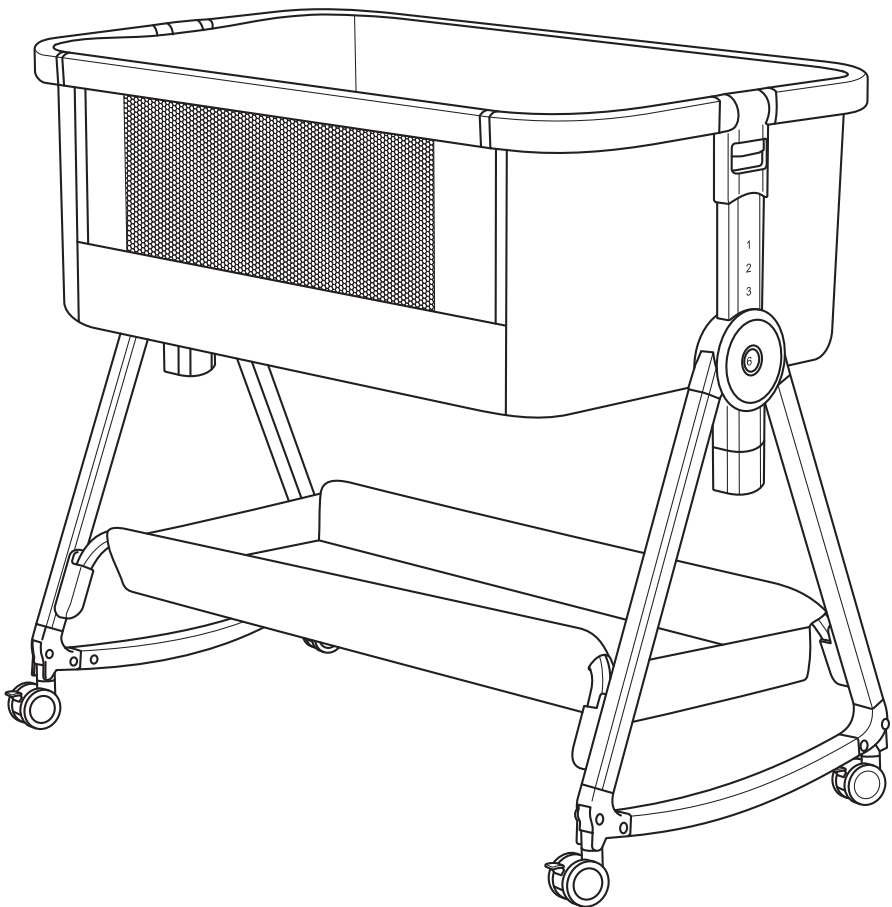

CO SLEEPER DELUXE INSTRUCTIONS MANUAL



IMPORTANT! RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE, READ CAREFULLY



WARNING



WARNING: Failure to follow these warning instructions could result in serious injury or death.

SUFFOCATION HAZARD

Infants have suffocated:

- In gaps between an extra pad and side of the co-sleeper.
- On soft bedding.
- NEVER add a mattress, pillow or comforter or padding.
- Use ONLY the pad provided by the manufacturer.

FALL HAZARD

To help prevent falls, DO NOT use this product when the infant begins to push up on hands and knees or has reached manufacturers recommended maximum weight of 9 kgs, whichever comes first.

- NEVER leave child unattended in the co-sleeper!

- Strings can cause strangulation! DO NOT place items with a string over a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. DO NOT suspend strings over a bassinet/cradle/ co-sleeper or attach strings to toys.
- To reduce the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS), pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their back to sleep, unless otherwise advised by a physician.

Users and guardians to read this instruction carefully before using it and keep it properly for future reference.

Failure to follow this instruction may affect the safety of children.

Beware of open fire or other strong heat sources near the crib! (such as EDM gas flame). Regular inspection during use, if you need to replace, please contact the manufacturer for replacement parts. Do not use replacement parts!

The Co Sleeper should be locked in a fixed position when unattended!

When the baby can sit up, kneel or climb up, do not use this Co Sleeper again!

Please do not use its product if the product is loose and damaged,!

Be sure to use the Co Sleeper on the horizontal floor. The baby must not be left unattended!

Do not put this product near the window!

Keep the plastic cover away from the baby to avoid asphyxia!

The thickness of the selected mat should ensure that the vertical height of the Co Sleeper is at least 200mm when the bottom deck is at the highest position.

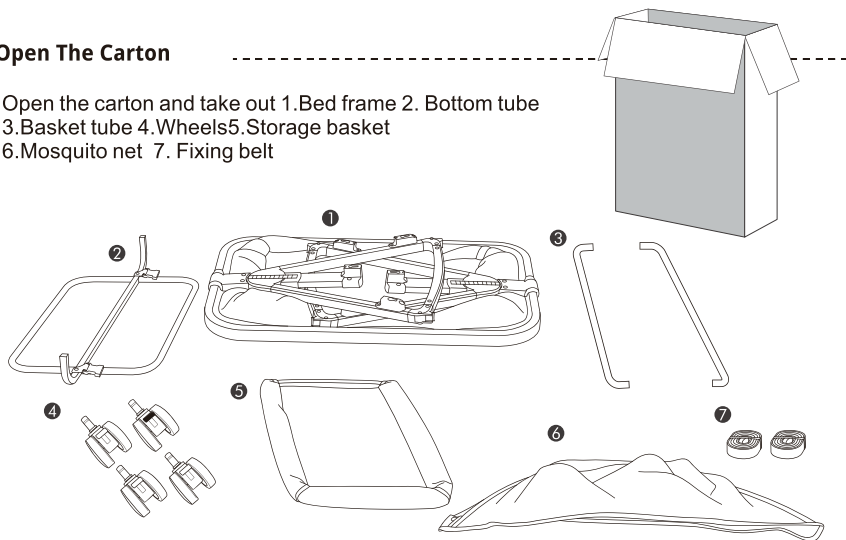
The maximum Load-bearing of baby weight 9kg!

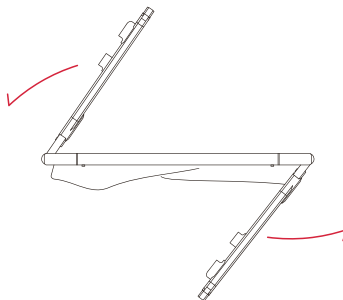
Open The Carton

Open the carton and take out 1. Bed frame 2. Bottom tube
3. Basket tube 4. Wheels 5. Storage basket
6. Mosquito net 7. Fixing belt

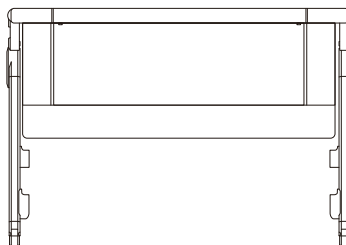


Unfold the bed frame

1. Please turn the foot tube in the bed frame to the outside.

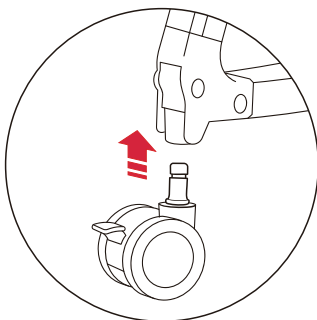


2. Turn the foot tube to the point where it is vertically stand, as picture shown.

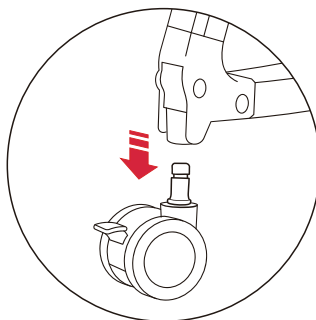

Wheel installation

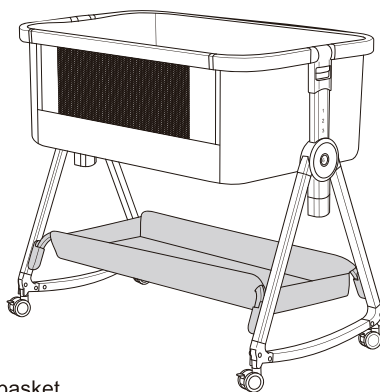
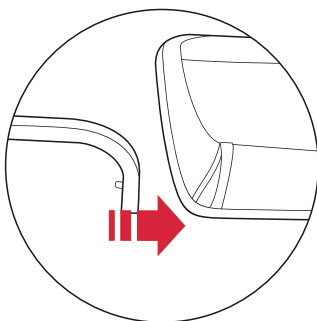


Wheel disassembly

Wheel installation: The four universal wheels are inserted into the supporting feet to complete the installation.

Wheel disassembly: The four universal wheels on the side of the Co Sleeper are drawn downward to disassemble the universal wheels.

Installing the storage basket

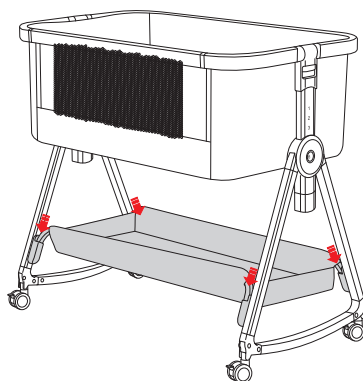


Two basket crossbars can be inserted into the basket.

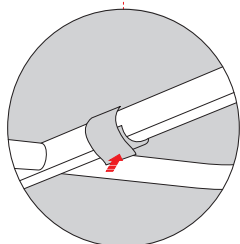
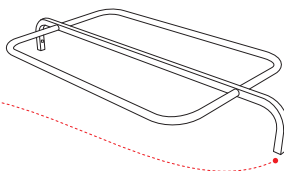
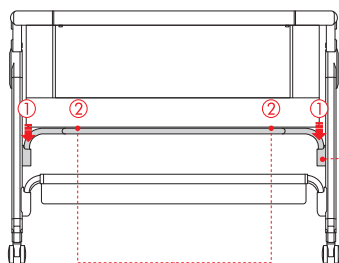

Installing the storage basket

As picture shown: Insert the basket into foot tubes separately. A "click" sound indicating the are locked into place.



Installing the bottom frame

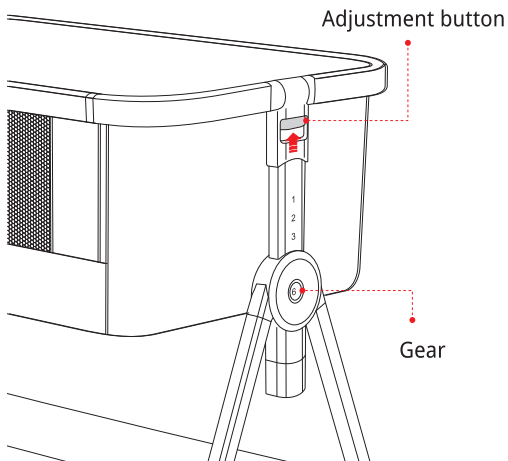


1. Place the two feet of the bottom bracket to the hole on the foot tubes, under the height Adjustment rods. A "click" sound indicating they are locked into place.

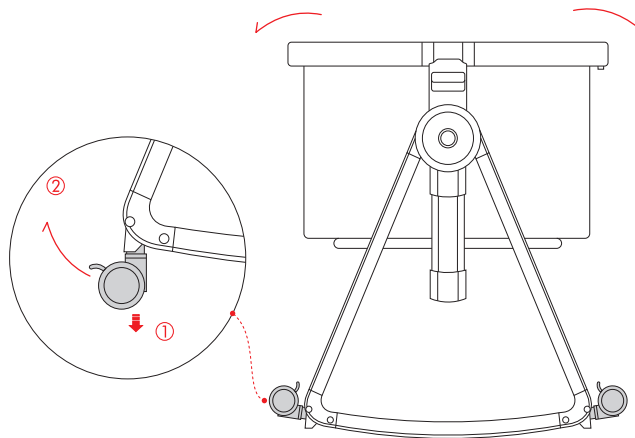
2. After feet are installed, fix the buckles on the two sides to the middle rod.

Rocking Mode

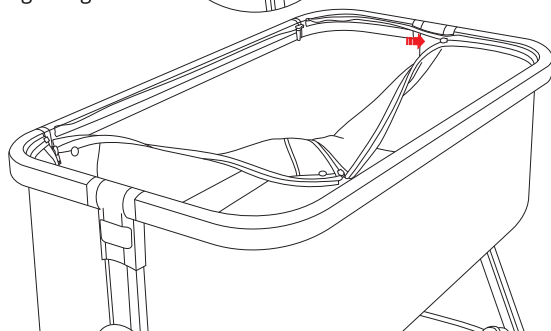
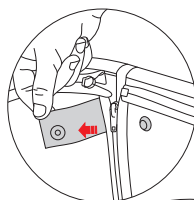


Pull down the four universal wheels on the bedside Co Sleeper then push them upwards, and the bedside Co Sleeper switch to the rocking mode.

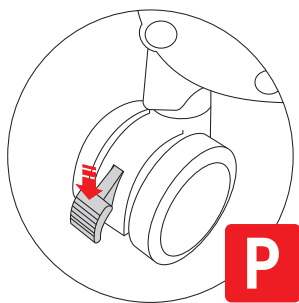

Fabric Cover Removal

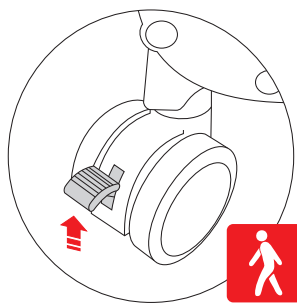
1. Detach the buckle on the zipper protector.
2. Remove the fabric cover by unzipping along the top edge of the bed frame.



The brake of bedside Co Sleeper



Step on the four brakes on the bedside Co Sleeper the Co Sleeper is on brakes.

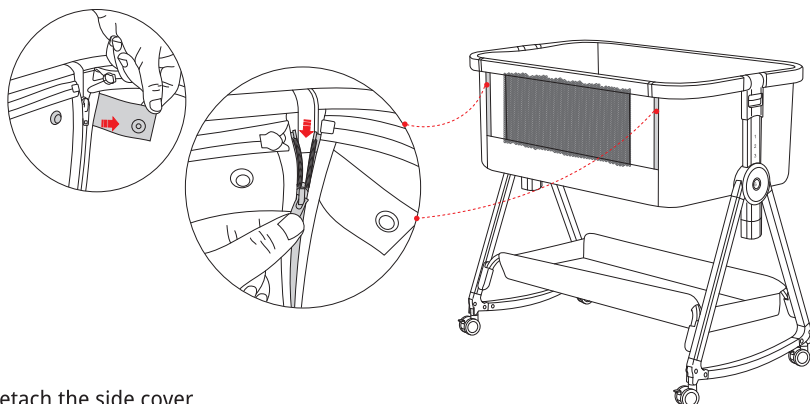


Lift the brakes on the bedside Co Sleeper. the Co Sleeper is on mobile position.

WARNING The four wheels must have ALL brakes on at all time when the Co Sleeper is used

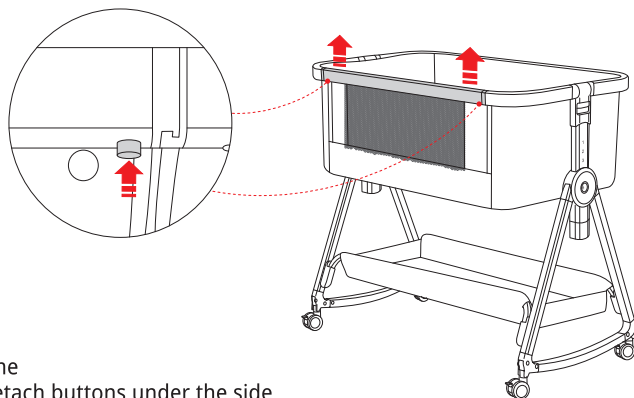

Attach to the Bed



Detach the side cover

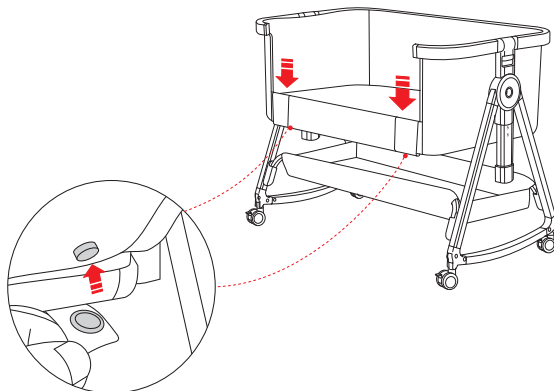
1. Detach the buckle on the zipper protector
2. Unzip the two zippers on two sides



Open the side frame

1. Press the two detach buttons under the side frame synchronously.
2. Lift the detached frame up and turn it downward.
3. After the side frame is turned down, please fasten the fixing belt and buckles on the bottom then finish.

Move the Co Sleeper close to the parent's bed and check the height of the Co Sleeper compared with the mattress on the bed.

The side support of the Co Sleeper should always be placed close to the parent's mattress and the mattress should always be aligned with the height of the side support for restraint of the Co Sleeper.

In order to fix the Co Sleeper to the parent's bed in co-sleeping mode, use the attached pair of attachment straps/-fixing belts provided.



WARNING
To avoid death from the infant's neck being caught on the top rail on the side that is next to the adult bed, the top rail must be no higher than the adult mattress. ALWAYS raise the side when not fastened to the adult bed.



WARNING

Entrapment Hazard - To prevent death from entrapment, bedside Co Sleeper must be properly secured to adult bed using the attachment straps.

- There must be no more than 1/2 Inch (13mm) gap between bedside Co Sleeper and adult bed
- Check tightness before each use by pulling bedside Co Sleeper in a direction away from adult bed.
- If gap exceeds 1/2 inch (13mm), DO NOT use product. Do not fill the gap with pillows, blankets or other items that are suffocation hazards

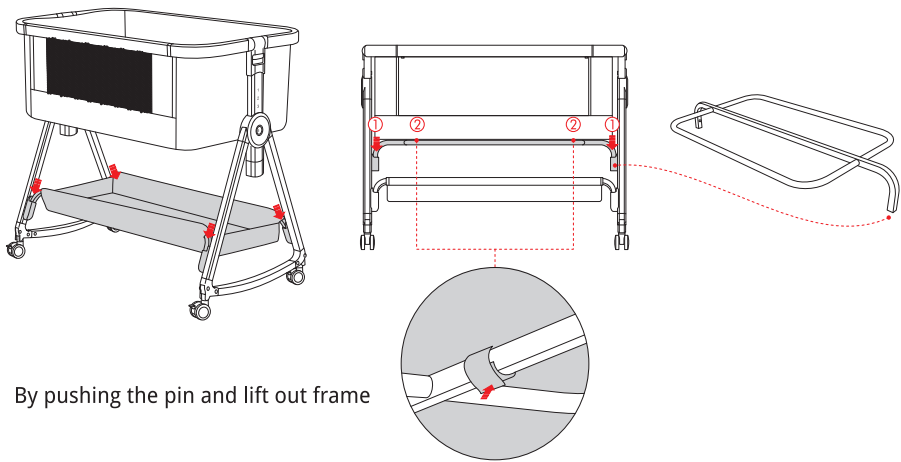
WARNING

The 2 attachment straps must always be used in bedside Co Sleeper mode.

ASSEMBLY / OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Folding the Bassinet

1. Remove the Tray/Storage Basket and the bottom frame



By pushing the pin and lift out frame

2. Fold both legs



3. Put the Co Sleeper in travel bag



HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR CO-SLEEPER DELUXE

Cleaning

This product has been designed and developed with safety, comfort and functionality in mind. Please take the time to read this manual carefully before using this product and keep it in a safe place for future reference.

To ensure the long-lasting use of your bedside Co Sleeper, do not use solvents, abrasives or aggressive cleaning products. After each wash check the resistance of the fabric and the stitching. For washing of the fabric, carefully comply with instructions indicated on the label (listed below).



Hand wash in cold water



DO NOT IRON



DO NOT BLEACH



DO NOT dry clean



DO NOT tumble dry

Maintenance

Always check parts regularly for tightness of screws, nuts and other fasteners - tighten or replace if required. The bedside Co Sleeper and the mattress have a resistant fabric cover which is completely removable and washable. The removal of the fabric should be carried out by an adult only. On a regular basis check the condition of the product and presence of any possible damage. In the case of damage do not use and keep it out of the reach of children. To maintain the safety of your bedside Co Sleeper seek prompt repairs for bent, torn, worn or broken parts.

Use only the parts and accessories approved by The Baby Factory.
